APPLICATION PROCEDURE: All students should apply online, no need to send original documents.

1. Register SISU online application system: <http://apply.shisu.edu.cn/>
2. Choose **Chinese Language Program Student (语言生)**, On step 1 study plan, in **study duration** blank, choose one semester/one year **Chinese language courses (汉语课程一学期/一学年)** to apply. In the blank of **First Preference-Major**: choose **Chinese Language Program (Non-Degree)/ 进修-汉语言 (普通)**.
3. in the blank of ‘Recommended by/Corporated university’ (推荐机构/合作院校), fill in the **school code** of home university (For school code, please refer to ANNEX 2)
4. On step 8 application fee, choose **Offline Payment**, in the blank of Payment Method, upload the nomination letter from home university (**picture format**), no need to pay the application fee. For payment information as remitter and date or other, just fill in any information. If you have paid, be noticed that the application fee is not refundable.
5. After filling all the steps, submit.

★ Before students applying online, **the international office** of your university should send the nomination name list (free format) to: yangliudai@shisu.edu.cn



TRAINING COURSES:

- 1) Mandarin courses offered in the morning (Compulsory course)
Including Comprehensive Chinese (grammar, conversation, and Chinese characters), Chinese Listening Comprehension, Chinese Reading and Chinese Conversation of various levels. (20 class hours per week and 340 class hours per semester. 1 class hour=45mins)
 - 2) English-taught courses offered in the afternoon (Optional course)
 - ★ Exchange students will receive a list of English-taught courses at the beginning of each semester and may sign up for them with the academic office. (2 class hours per week for each course and 30 class hours per semester) (Annex 1 are the course lists for the previous year which can be a reference for the coming exchange students).
 - 3) Chinese-taught courses offered in the afternoon (Optional course)
HSK Tutoring, Chinese Characters Writing, Calligraphy, Taiji boxing, etc.
- ★ All the above courses are taught in HongKou campus.
 - ★ The courses will be adjusted every year. The affirmatory courses list will be published after semester starts.
 - ★ The courses are for students having HSK level from 0 to 5, there's no course for HSK 6 level, and **not suitable for Chinese students**.
 - ★ There's no degree courses for exchange students.

ACCEPTANCE AND VISA:

- 1) SISU checks application materials.
- 2) Once accepted, SISU will send **TWO** documents by **E-mail**.
 - A: Acceptance letter: will be sent to the international office and students' E-mail address.
 - B: JW202 form (if less than 6 months, it is called short term information form): will be sent to students' E-mail address
- 3) Applicants should print these two documents and go to the Chinese Embassy or Consulate to apply for a student visa (X1 or X2).
 - ★ X2 visa only have one exit and entry during your stay.

REGISTRATION: Students can scan the QR code on the Acceptance letter for detailed registration

information.
