Natural (Yongin) Campus

Myongji University's Yongin Campus not only boasts rich educational infrastructure but is also located near cutting-edge industrial facilities, such as the world's largest semiconductor production complex and the Mugunghwa Satellite Control Center. Leveraging Yongin's abundant educational and cultural resources, the Natural Campus offers excellent accessibility (about an hour from Seoul), a nature-friendly learning environment, and state-of-the-art educational facilities. - ✦ **Class Size:** Around 15 students per class
- ✦ **Course Levels:** Level 1 (Beginner), Level 2 (Beginner), Level 3 (Intermediate), Level 4 (Intermediate), Level 5 (Advanced), Level 6 (Advanced)
- ✦ **Course Duration:** 10 weeks per semester, 5 days a week (Monday–Friday), 4 hours per day (total 200 hours)
- ✦ **Class Hours:** Level 1 and 2 : 14:00–18:00, Level 3, 4, 5, 6 : 09:00–13:00
- ✦ **Textbooks:** Korean Language Student Book A/B, Workbook A/B (Seoul National University Press)
- ✦ **Language of Instruction:** Korean
- ✦ **Class Placement:** Classes are organized according to learners' levels based on written and speaking assessments

5. Original Certificate of KRW Bank Balance 10,000,000 (Applicant)	Check the required deposit period for visa issuance by country before submission. Document must be issued within 30 days after the application period starts. If the account is under the parents' name, documents No. 6 and 7 must also be submitted.

[4-Semester Registration] Additional Required Documents for Designated Countries	
6. Copy of Parents' ID (one each)	English name must be indicated
7. Original Family Relationship Certificate (or Birth Certificate showing parents' names)	English name must be indicated
8. Original Certificate of Employment & Income Certificate of the Financial Guarantor (Parent)	
9. Original Letter of Guarantee from a Korean Guarantor & Certificate of Employment * Notarization by a law office is required	Only for applicants requested to submit

* All documents must be submitted in Korean, English, or Chinese.
(Documents in other languages must be translated and notarized.)

* Additional documents may be requested during the document review process.

* Submitted documents will not be returned.

Academic Verification Requirements by Country

Ⓞ Apostille Convention Countries: Submit the original Apostille certificate
Ⓞ China
- Submit the Academic Verification Report issued by the Chinese Ministry of Education (chsi.com.cn or cdgdc.edu.cn)
- For graduates of vocational or technical high schools, please check the Chinese website carefully and submit the required documents accordingly
Ⓞ Non-Apostille Countries and Applicants Other Than Chinese Nationals: Submit a Consular Confirmation issued by the Korean embassy or consulate

* All academic verification documents must be submitted by post in original form.
